


04.12.2023: Observation of Constitution Day: On the occasion of Constitution Day of India on






DEPARTMENT OF HISTORY

16/10/2024: Library Orientation: Library orientation was organized for the first-year students to acquaint them with the functioning of the library.







STUDENT PROGRESSION (EMPLOYMENT) REPORT, 2023-2024

It has been noted that quite a number of students have been placed in govt. services after the completion of their graduation from Dwijendralal College.

The progression of students from Dwijendralal College into government services has been analyzed, with academic credentials verified by the local DIB.

Among the graduates placed, the distribution across departments (percentage calculated out of the total number of students got placed) reveals a significant presence from various academic streams.




- *B.A. General students constitute the largest portion, with 43.2% of total placements,* indicating the broad appeal and versatility of the program.
- *B.A. Honours students follow closely, comprising 32.4% of placements*, showcasing the depth of knowledge and specialisation within their field.

- *B.Com. General students represent a smaller yet notable segment, contributing*5.4% to the total placements, reflecting the practical application of commerce studies.
- *B.Com. Honours students, with 18.9% of placements*, demonstrate a strong presence in government services, highlighting the value of in-depth study in the field.

The distribution underscores the diverse academic offerings at Dwijendralal College, catering to a range of career paths and opportunities.

Continued collaboration with the local DIB ensures the accuracy and reliability of academic credentials, bolstering the credibility of graduates in the job market.

2ND DECEMBER: SWACHATA AVIYAN




The volunteers of NSS collaborated with neighbouring schools to clean the surrounding areas of the college and schools.

The NSS Volunteers went to the Kolkata National Library alongwith the students of other departments of the college and gain various kinds of knowledge which can be helpful for them in future.


